

2008 Virginia General Assembly
Legislative Report
1/20/2008

As we entered the second week of the 2008 session, nearly 2000 bills and resolutions have been filed. The deadline for submitting bills for introduction was last Friday at 5 p.m., so by early next week we should have all 2008 legislation before us. I expect another 1000 or so bills and resolutions to come down the chute by that time.

As you can see from the attached matrix, we already have a boatload of bills affecting our sector. But while the numbers of industry-related bills appears unusually large, the number of bills that have a snowman's chance of succeeding is not, in fact, a large number. For example there are lots of bills introduced to essentially dismantle the regional transportation authorities, along with their local taxing powers, created in last year's transportation funding legislation - HB 3202. Not going to happen!

More constructively, there are some bills like Sen. Blevins SB 176 and Sen. Saslaw's SB 729 that tweak HB 3202 in ways that may make sense, or at the very least, deserve some discussion among legislators. VUHCC position on these "tweak bills" is really not to reopen the whole can of worms regarding the merits of HB 3202, but rather to try and ensure that any changes are, at the very least, revenue neutral for their respective regions, and at best create more funding streams for local transportation projects, as Sen. Blevins' bill would for the Tidewater area.

Legislators from the Richmond area are now realizing that creating regional authorities to fund and oversee local transportation projects may be the only legislative approach that can generate new and substantial transportation funding AND pass legislative muster in Virginia. So Richmond Delegate Frank Hall and Senator John Watkins have each introduced bills (no bill numbers assigned yet) to try and get the ball rolling in central Virginia. Each bill is slightly different, but they both are intended to serve as a catalyst for creation of a local transportation funding/construction entity. Reaction from regional leaders has been mixed so far, but VUHCC is urging Richmond area legislators to get such a framework in place, even if local governments then choose not to use it immediately.

This week saw all of the many Senate bills dealing with the repeal of the Abusive Driver Fees rolled into one bill (SB 1) in the Senate Courts Committee, and rereferred Sen. Houck's bill to the Senate Finance Committee for final disposition in the Senate. The deal was to go for flat-out repeal, but not to refund fees already paid under this newly-enacted, and hotly-contested program that was supposed to raise more than \$50 million a year in new transportation funding dollars. On the House side, the Transportation Committee voted 19-1 for repeal this week, and the Governor announced that he not only wanted repeal, but he sought emergency legislation so that the repeal would go into effect immediately upon passage and his signature, as opposed to the normal July 1st effective date of non-emergency legislation. While VUHCC did not support the creation of these fees, our concern now should they be repealed - and as I mentioned in last week's report, I think they are going to be repealed - is how are we going to make up the lost revenues (which it turns out is way less than the anticipated \$50-\$60 million annually).

And aside from Transportation, there is a frighteningly large block of bills that would negatively impact trucks in such ways as granting all localities the ability to weigh and assess fines to those they find overweight, to creating a new schedule of overweight penalties that would be adjusted every four years to determine what the liquidated damage fee schedule should be, based on a study of "the added maintenance costs associated with increased weight" of the truck (HB 1551). VUHCC is strongly opposed to this legislation, especially since we have, in the last five years, agreed twice to increases in the liquidated damages section of the code dealing with overweight trucks.

The second big block of troubling bills deals with the hot-button issue of immigration. Most are like, or offer some variation of, HB 1558, which basically creates additional employer burdens in an effort to ensure that only those workers and independent contractor that are "legally eligible for employment" are hired. A single violation could remove a contractor from being able to do business (debarred) with the state and localities and some go as far as saying that if such a violation is discovered after a contract is let or is in progress, the contract would be immediately terminated! VUHCC finds that most of these bills are pretty draconian given the nature of the infraction. We continue to argue that the burden of controlling illegal aliens is a federal issue, and enforcement should

not drop into the laps of small business simply because no one else has been successful in effectively dealing with this problem. Finally, if the burden is going to be dropped on small business, there needs to be a quick, easy, reliable mechanism in place for businesses to use, and if they do be off the hook for the sudden-death penalties many of the bills on this subject create. Most of this legislation will, I believe, be combined into one or two bills that will hopefully address our concerns. We will be watching and working on them in the meantime.
