

2008 Virginia General Assembly  
Legislative Report  
2/2/2008

Next week is one of those traditional "crunch weeks" at the General Assembly, as both House and Senate fast approach the weekend deadline for consideration of bills that have originated in their own chambers. After next weekend, with the exception of certain money-related legislation and some other special exceptions, the House will only be considering Senate bills that survived the Senate, and the Senate will similarly be voting only on House legislation.

At this stage in the session VUHCC is working on two main areas: Transportation Funding, and Immigration/Hiring Restrictions,

Transportation Funding

With the now certain demise of the abusive driver fees, I, am other transportation lobbyists, along with many legislators are still scrambling as we try and determine the best way to replace the lost revenues that were supposed to be generated from this doomed approach to raising transportation dollars. So far, these conversations have yielded little in the way of substantive proposals.

The anti-tax republican-controlled House seems content to not take any bold steps for replacing or exceeding the lost revenues, which range from 16 to 60 million dollars a year, depending on whom you want to believe. The democrat-controlled Senate has a few bills out there which call for increases in the gas tax, one or two of which stand a chance of making it out of the Senate. The chances of success take a nose-dive, however, if and when those proposals reach the House of Delegates.

There has also been some discussion about increasing the options associated with horse racing/gaming in Virginia, such as the introduction of "Instant Racing" with some of the proceeds to be used for transportation. My guess is this too sinks quickly if and when it arrives in the House, which has not been known to embrace moves towards more gambling options in Virginia.

I have suggested, to mixed reviews, that we need to start talking again about raising the sales tax on auto sales (titling tax) which is 2% below the sales tax on all other purchases in Virginia, and has been artificially low for many years due to the power of the auto dealers' lobby. A 1% increase in this fee generates in excess of \$200 million/year and is a tax increase directly related to roads. In fairness, this too has been suggested in the last two years and has always been "stuffed" in the House. I think it needs more discussion, however, at this session of the General Assembly.

Finally, there is some growing inertia to try and address transportation funding as part of the development of the 2008-10 state budget, a process that would be much more closed but may stand the greatest chance for success. We are trying to watch this discussion closely, to determine if it really has any legs!

Immigration

I have previously discussed the many bills introduced at this session, most of which placed onerous restrictions and/or penalties on businesses who are caught employing a worker with an incorrect alien status. We opposed many of these bills, but given the political mood indicating that something was going to pass on this subject, we have talked with, and expressed no opposition to, Sen. Cucinelli's SB 517. As opposed to the many other bills we opposed, this bill does not proscribe certain steps a contractor must take to ensure immigration compliance. Rather, it simply requires that contractors have taken steps to confirm the immigration status verification of their employees. This approach is, by far, the best legislative language we have seen and I believe requires an action that most VUHCC members are already taking. We also are not opposed to SB 783 which allows state licensing boards to assess a penalty to an employer who has been convicted of violating employment law regarding illegal aliens. We continue to oppose all of the other bills dealing with this subject.

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On the subject of bad truck legislation, I think all of the bad legislation has been effectively dealt with at this time. SB 558, HB 1546, HB 292, and HB 1112 have all been put to bed as this session. Hopefully, no

additional bills will pop up until the 2009 session, when the whole process will undoubtedly repeat itself.

This week we will be opposing two bills introduced by Delegate Frederick from northern Virginia. One would preclude many of your workers from parking a company pick-up truck in front of their homes (HB 1027) and another that I believe would require companies of any size who do even small amounts of work with the state to develop a policy for "telecommuting", (like we need the state to now be telling us what we must do in that area!)

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Next week we will provide an update on the battle being fought by the state's homebuilders, realtors, and local governments over whether to do away with proffers and expand the applicability of impact fees as well as discuss the proposed constitutional amendment to allow local governments to exempt up to 20% of a home's value from local real estate taxes (that might seem just dandy but the implication for businesses could be very costly!).
