

**2008 Virginia General Assembly  
Legislative Report  
2/16/2008**

The big news this week was the budget, or as some are saying on Capitol Hill, "what's left of it!" Pre-session estimates of a couple of hundred million dollar shortfall by the Governor have now been adjusted to somewhere between \$1.4 and \$2 billion dollars covering the remainder of this fiscal year, and the July 08 to June 2010 new budget. That is starting to sound like "real money".

The fallout is that House Republicans will now start picking apart the Governor's proposed budget for the next two years, which are considered the "legacy years" for this Governor. They will oppose any of his new programs, especially when the fiscal situation requires that money must be taken from existing programs to fund them. This is NOT a good place for the Governor to be.

Transportation funding received a boost this past week as both SB 597 and SB 713 passed both the Senate Finance Committee and the full Senate. SB 713 is the only gas tax bill that is still breathing at the session, and VUHCC lobbied for its passage. It increases the current 17.5 cent gas tax by a penny a year for the next five years, with each penny bringing in around \$52 million a year. The Senate vote on this legislation had every Democrat voting for it, and every Republican save four (Quayle, Watkins, Blevins, and Hanger) voting against it, ending in a vote of 25 in favor and 15 against. The patron of the bill has asked me to lobby hard for this bill on the House side but guess what! No matter how hard this bill is lobbied, it is going to die in the House because it contains the "T" word!

That leaves SB 597 as the only remaining vehicle among the 1200 bills and resolutions that are still alive at the 08 session, that can produce any new revenues for transportation which in case you haven't been reading my earlier reports, is in a much more severe funding crunch than most realize. SB 597 allows for Virginia's only horse track to engage in "simulcast horse racing", which is essentially watching a previously run race on a computer screen, and betting on it. Each 1000 of such machines would generate about \$33 million for the Transportation Trust Fund, and this legislation contemplates putting 3000 machines into the track and the OTB parlors currently situated around the state. But the safest bet you can make, and one which will

not generate a single penny for transportation, is to bet that the Republican-controlled House will kill this bill as well. Why? Well they killed it last year, they are not keen on expanding the state's gaming options, and some have trouble rationalizing the expansion of horse racing as a way to fund transportation. If this bill wasn't the only funding option left, and the situation wasn't so dire, I am not sure VUHCC would disagree with those perspectives.

SB 768, which in broad terms substitutes impact fees for proffers, squeaked out of the Senate this week, on a vote of 21 to 19. This was not a party line vote, and both the yeas and the nays had plenty of R's and D's. The waters should be calmer for this controversial legislation over on the House side but even if it passes there, which it is expected to, the Governor still has to bless the bill. The tea leaves at this point suggest he will not.

Finally, SB 486 and HB 11 have now passed their respective houses 36 to 3 and 99 to 0. Both bills provides for a referendum at the November 2008 election to approve a proposed constitutional amendment relating to property tax exemptions. The proposed amendment authorizes the General Assembly to enact legislation that will allow localities by ordinance to exempt or partially exempt from real property taxes, or defer real property taxes on, up to 20 percent of the value of residential or farm property that is the owner-occupant's primary dwelling and lived in continuously. If approved by the voters, the amendment will take effect January 1, 2009. Voters will surely approve this referendum, and local governments will surely be pressured into cutting their real estate tax income by 20%. So the question then becomes, where will localities make up this shortfall. Can you spell "business"?!
