

Legislative Report- 1/20/2013

Please find below the comprehensive weekly report prepared by Myles Louria from our Hunton and Williams lobbying team. It provides an excellent overview of legislation of interest to date, and I encourage you to review Myles' comments carefully and explore important legislation further by clicking on the bill numbers contained in the attached matrix.

Be advised that we are also working on two important lien law proposals, HB 1436 which we spent a lot of time on last year and continue to be troubled by, and HB 1913 which we are trying to amend so that liens are not disqualified as a result of making an error in complying with the bill's new requirements. Also be advised that HB 2313 (the governor's transportation bill referenced by Myles below is not showing up in the matrix because it has not been printed yet.

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The Road to the Future

In the past week dozens of business, labor and transportation groups from around the Commonwealth have joined VUHCC in support of the Governor's proposed transportation funding plan which he has dubbed, "The Road to the Future". These groups include local chambers of commerce from around the state, a number of large trade groups (VA Auto Dealers Association, VA Association of Realtors, VA Homebuilders Association), and individual businesses (DuPont, Norfolk Southern, CSX, Wawa). While a strong cross-section of businesses have rallied in support of the Governor's transportation plan, some conservative groups have voiced their concern, or in some cases their opposition to the Governor's plan. The conservative anti-tax group, Americans for Tax Reform, have called the Governor's transportation funding plan, "a massive \$1.22 billion tax increase".

This week should be an important one for the transportation funding debate. The Governor's funding plan on the House side is included in HB 2313 which is sponsored by Speaker Bill Howell (R-Stafford County) and Delegate Tim Hugo (R-Fairfax County). The companion bill on the Senate side has not been assigned a number as of yet, but the bill will be sponsored by Senate Transportation Chairman Senator Steve Newman (R-Lynchburg). It is likely that the House Finance Committee, where all of the funding bill introduced have been referred, will ensure that the Governor's plan is the lone vehicle for transportation funding on the House side. The Governor's plan enjoys support among a broad range of factions within the House Republican Caucus - from conservatives like Delegate Kirk Cox (R-Colonial Heights) to more moderate members of the caucus like Delegate Tom Rust (R-Fairfax County).

The prospects for the Governor's bill is not nearly as clear on the Senate side, where Republicans and Democrats have voiced concerns about the measure both publically and privately. Under the heading of one of the more public pronounce-

ments, Senate Majority leader Dick Saslaw (D-Fairfax County) told the Washington Post that the Governor's measure "is so dead it's unbelievable." Republican moderates in the Senate (and all of the Democratic Caucus) oppose the use of general funds included in the Governor's plan (while some conservatives appear worried that the elimination of the gas tax will not provide direct relief at the pump for consumers and will instead increase the profit of the oil companies). It is not clear at this point whether the Governor's bill will actually be the vehicle the Senate chooses to continue the discussion on transportation funding. There seems to be a strong chance that the preferred vehicle for these discussions will be SB 717, sponsored by Senator John Watkins (R-Powhatan County). Senator Watkins' bill, includes no general fund revenues, and establishes a 5% tax on gas at the wholesale level while lowering the income tax rate for the lowest earners. The bill also repeals a host of transportation related tax credits. Senator Watkins' measure has more immediate new, long-term revenues for transportation, but the plan would likely have a difficult road with conservatives who control the House of Delegates.

Legislation of Interest:

Friday was the final day for members to introduce bills (the Governor has the ability to send legislation down at any time during the session. Members can still file bills if they receive unanimous consent from their colleagues, which happens on a limited basis). Legislation of interest to VUHCC members that has been introduced includes :

Transportation Funding:

HB 1409, HB 1438 and HB 1888, which all propose some form of gas tax indexing, will be among the bills that will likely be killed this week in the House Finance Committee. These bills (or variations of them) have failed in the House in previous sessions.

EZ Pass Transponder Fees:

HB 1779 was introduced this week by Delegate Filler-Corn (D-Fairfax) and, like HB 1302, proposed by Delegate Loupassi (R-Henrico), prevents VDOT from charging monthly fees for EZ Pass transponders. Both are awaiting Transportation committee action.

Procurement:

VUHCC met with both Senator John Miller (D-Newport News) and Delegate David Yancey (R-Newport News) regarding their bid match preference bills (SB 990 and HB 1951 respectively). These bills would allow Virginia companies to match the lowest bid of an out-of-state bidder if the in-state bidder is within 5% of the lowest bid of the out-of-state bidder). VUHCC briefed both Senator Miller and Delegate Yancey on our objections to the bills. Delegate Yancey responded by agreeing to strike his bill in General Laws Subcommittee. Senator Miller has agreed to strike his bill this week in the Senate General Laws Subcommittee.

VUHCC also led the fight against another preference bill, HB 1882 sponsored by Delegate Joe Morrissey (D-Richmond). The measure would have required all public bodies to include in every contract of more than \$100,000 a provisions requiring the contractor to agree that 51% of all positions created in performance of the contract would be filled by Virginia residents and that 35% of the total hours worked by apprentices in positions created in performance of the contract would be performed by Virginia residents. VUHCC testified before the House General Laws Subcommittee, and discussed the measure with members of the Subcommittee prior to the meeting last week. The bill was rejected on a vote of 5-2.

Overweight Permits

HB 1386, submitted by Delegate Bob Tata (R-Virginia Beach), would allow the court to invalidate a standard overweight permit in circumstances where a super load permit was required. This bill was defeated in committee this week.

Restrictions on Cell Phones and Texting:

This week SB 1005, patroned by Senator Jeff McWaters (R-Virginia Beach), passed the Transportation committee and is headed to the Senate floor. The proposed bill makes using a handheld personal communication device while driving on a bridge or in a tunnel a primary offense. All other offenses involving the use of a handheld personal communication device while driving remain secondary offenses. The bill also increases the penalty for causing an accident because of the use of a handheld personal communications device while driving on a bridge or in a tunnel to \$150 for a first offense and \$250 for a second or subsequent offense.

The House Criminal Law Subcommittee will hear HB 1360 sponsored by Delegates Ben Cline (R-Rockbridge County) and Scott Surovell (D-Fairfax County) this week. The bill provides that driving while using a handheld communications device for something other than verbal communication constitutes driving a motor vehicle that is not under proper control, punishable as reckless driving.
