

Legislative Report- 2/24/2013

Transportation Funding Package:

Speaker Bill Howell's transportation funding bill (HB 2313) which passed the General Assembly will generate approximately \$1.3 billion a year in new, sustainable transportation revenues when fully implemented (full implementation will occur in 2018). The funding package:

- Provides an additional \$500 million annually which will eliminate the crossover effect where construction revenues from the Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) have been transferred to the Highway Maintenance and Operating Fund (HMOF). Eliminating crossover frees up significant revenues for construction projects.
- Provides regional funding packages for Northern Virginia (\$300-\$350 million annually) and Hampton Roads (\$173 million growing to \$219 million annually).
- Prohibits tolling of existing lanes of Interstate 95 South of Fredericksburg
- Provides a dedicated funding source for mass transit and intercity passenger rail (\$84 million and \$56 million a year respectively by 2018. Phase II of the Dulles Rail project also receives \$300 million.
- Provides additional funding for K-12 public education by earmarking a portion of the existing sales tax (1/8th) to education.

The funding plan specifically scraps Virginia's 17.5 cents per gallon tax on gasoline and applies a 3.5 percent tax on the wholesale price of fuel (which is equaled to approximately 11.5 cents per gallon on the price of fuel - the additional percentage at the wholesale level will keep pace with economic growth and inflation), as well as a 6 percent tax on the wholesale price of diesel fuel. The revenues generated from the funding package are a combination of existing general fund dollars (\$198 million of existing sales tax revenue earmarked for transportation) and tax and fee increases, including:

1. Increase in the retail sales tax from 5 percent to 5.3 percent
2. Increase in the motor vehicle titling tax on new vehicles from 3 percent to 4.3 percent
3. An additional \$100 registration fee for hybrid vehicles
4. Earmarks a percentage of sales tax from online retailers (this portion of the plan is predicated on Congressional action on federal legislation known as the "Marketplace Equity Act". If Congress does not pass the measure by 2015, the wholesale tax on gas will increase to 5.1 percent).

The bill creates regional funding mechanisms which boost the sales tax from the newly increased 5.3 percent to 6 percent in both Northern Virginia and Hampton Roads. Northern Virginia also includes a 3% increase in transient occupancy taxes and an increase in the grantor's tax regarding real estate. Hampton Roads adds an additional 2% on the wholesale price of gas. These revenues will be raised and spent on transportation projects in those two regions.

HB 2313 passed the House by a 62-38 margin, with 35 Republicans and one Independent joining 26 Democrats in supporting the measure. In the Senate, the vote was 25-15, with only 8 Republicans joining 17 Democrats in securing the bill's passage. While the funding package received bi-partisan support, a majority of Republicans in the Senate, and 32 of the House Republican Caucus' 67 members strongly opposed the bill due to the fee and tax increases included in the measure. A much smaller number of Democrats in the House and Senate (only 8 of the 52 Democrats in the House and Senate opposed the bill either because of their opposition to increasing the sales tax – which they believed disproportionately impacted the urban poor, or a disagreement over forcing residents of Northern Virginia or Hampton to pay more on a regional basis). Anti-tax segments within the Republican Party appear poised to initiate nomination contests for a number

of Republicans who supported the funding package. For example, House Transportation Chairman Joe May (R-Loudoun County), who has been a steadfast supporter of transportation funding and was a key supporter of the Speaker's bill, already will face a primary contest from a member of the TEA Party.

Governor McDonnell will have approximately 30 days to offer amendments to the transportation package (some members of the General Assembly have already asked the Governor to offer amendments to the bill). Secretary Sean Connaughton told a gathering of legislators from the House of Delegates that the Governor would only offer technical amendments to the bill, and not suggest substantive changes to the measure. It is unclear, at least at the moment, if Governor McDonnell intends to limit the scope of his amendments.

Other Legislation of Interest During the 2013 Session:

Mechanics Lien:

VUHCC secured an amendment to Delegate Scott Surovell's (D-Fairfax County) mechanics lien bill that will ensure that members' interests are protected as HB 1913 moved through the General Assembly. The amendment effectively addresses concerns regarding the possibility that a lien could be invalidated if a contractor inadvertently makes a mistake in preparing the lien paperwork. The bill, which passed the Senate and the House unanimously, is expected to be signed by the Governor. The bill provides that a person who is not a licensed contractor may not claim a mechanic's lien if a valid contractor's license or certificate was required by law for the labor performed or materials furnished.

Procurement:

HB 2079, sponsored by the Chairman of the General Laws Committee Chris Jones (R-Suffolk), reorganized the definitions of competitive sealed bidding and competitive negotiation, and added a definition of job order contracting. The bill was amended in the Senate which added certain additional considerations for job order contracting. Those amendments were rejected by the House. The conferenced committee largely embraced the House's language for the bill. The conference committee report was accepted unanimously by the House and Senate. The Governor will now consider amendments to the measure.

Restrictions on Cell Phones and Texting:

SB 1222, patroned by Senate Majority Leader Tommy Norment (R-James City County) and HB 1907, patroned by Delegate Rich Anderson (R-Prince William) are identical measures which provide that driving while texting is an infraction punishable by a fine of \$250 and, for a second or subsequent offense, by a fine of \$500. The bill also increases the punishment of any person convicted of reckless driving to include a \$500 mandatory minimum fine if the person was texting at the time of the reckless driving offense. The bill also changes the offense from a secondary offense (one that can only be charged when the offender is stopped for another, separate offense) to a primary offense. The measure is now being considered by the Governor.
